

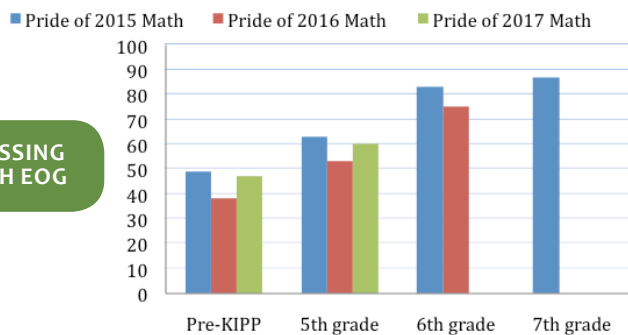

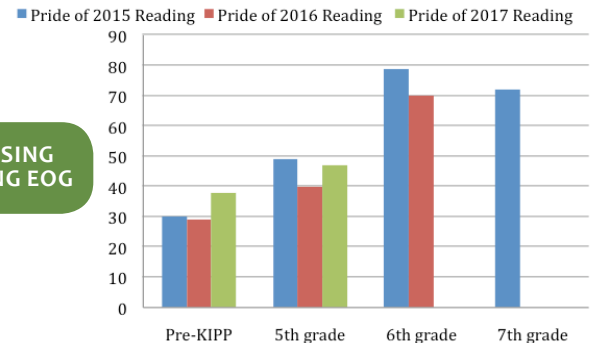
### The Pride Grows at KIPP

## The Mission

KIPP Charlotte prepares all of our students to excel in the nation's finest high schools and colleges by cultivating the habits of mind, character skills, and knowledge necessary for their success. We provide an education that will enable our students to lead full lives and empower our graduates to be the future leaders of Charlotte and agents of change in the world beyond.

## About KIPP

KIPP Charlotte is a member of KIPP, the Knowledge Is Power Program, a national network of free, open-enrollment, college-preparatory public schools with a track record of preparing students in under-resourced communities for success in college and in life. There are currently 99 locally-run KIPP schools in 19 states and Washington, DC, which are serving around 20,000 students. While less than one in five low-income students typically attends college nationally, 87% of KIPP alumni have gone on to college.

## Our Academic Program

KIPP Charlotte students attend school from **7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** Monday to Thursday, and **7:30 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.** on Fridays. Students are required to attend school **two Saturdays each month from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.** and a **mandatory two-week summer session**. Students at KIPP Charlotte receive on average **70% more instruction** time than their peers at traditional public and private schools.

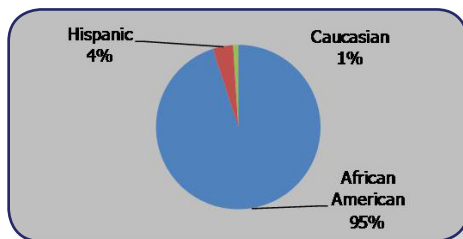

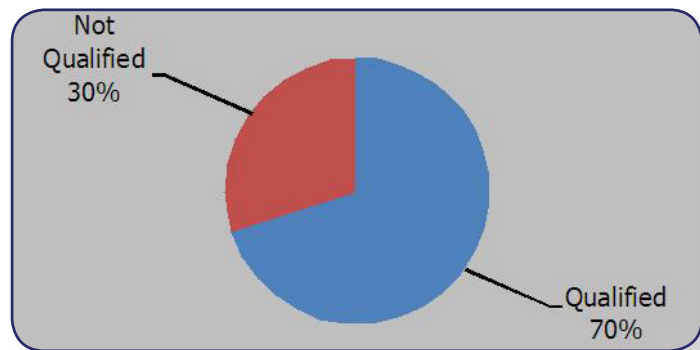
## Demography is Not Destiny

Ethnicity of KIPP CHARLOTTE students.



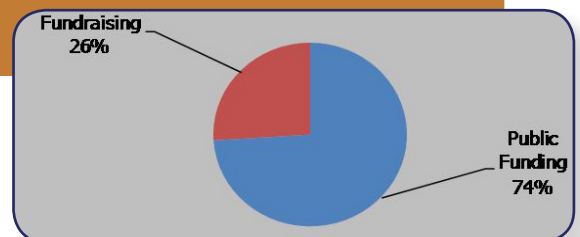
Students who qualify for free or reduced meals.

## Some Facts on KIPP Charlotte:

- It costs \$9,000 to educate a student at KIPP Charlotte.
- 74% of those costs come from public funding.
- The remaining 26% is generously donated by individuals, private foundations, corporations and organizations. (See graph)



## Useful Stats about KIPP Parents

- 100% of parents who have a child attending KIPP Charlotte stated they would recommend the school.
- 95% of parents stated that KIPP Charlotte has had a positive influence on their child's behavior outside of school.
- Over 95% of parents surveyed feel that KIPP Charlotte is preparing their child for a competitive highschool and college.
- Over 95% of parents surveyed state they would recommend a friends child go to KIPP.
